

Statement of Service

Art Department, Augustana College

To achieve tenure, a faculty member is expected to provide services to the Art Department, the College, the local community, and/or nationally or internationally.

Service within the Art Department might include:

- Assisting with orientation and/or admissions events
- Assisting with high school recruitment;
- Serving on the Art Museum Advisory Board
- Helping organize student art/design shows
 - or assist with student club activities
- Contributing to department's operational and programming decisions, assessment and other projects
- Assisting with Kaleidoscope, the College's children's art program
- Co-curricular Activities including field trips
- Help promote department events
- Finding internship placements

Service on campus might include:

- First year advising
- General education courses
- Serving on college committees
- Participation in a learning community or one of Augustana's international study programs
- Participation in Symposium Days
- Designing promotional, presentational, or instructional materials
- Acting as a Faculty Advisor to student clubs and organizations
- Organizing campus-wide events
- Curatorial and consulting services for the Augustana Teaching Museum of Art

Services to the community/country/globe might include:

- Serving as consultant for professional or civic organizations, or university and school programs
- Serving as invited speaker to community groups, libraries, organizations, or helping with such organizations in general;
- Helping or donating art works to causes deemed worthy;
- Visiting schools to discuss art or other topics
- Designing materials for other organizations
- Public Art Commissions

It is the responsibility of the faculty to track and present such services. The quality of the faculty member's involvement in public service may be supported by endorsement from the representatives of the community organizations involved.
